International Student Dinner - Sat, February 20th

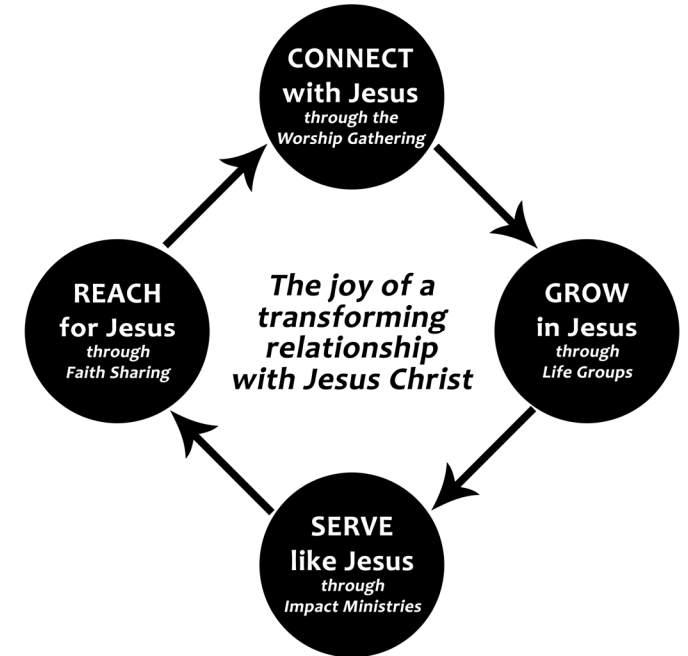
