The sooner you sign up, the more likely you are to get the time you want. Each family getting a photo made will receive a free 8" X 10" portrait and a free directory.

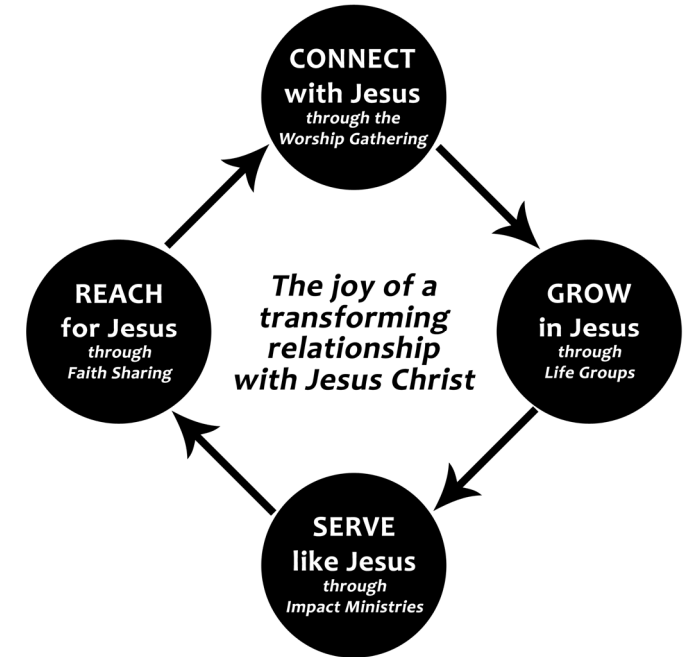
