Friendly Avenue Baptist Church WMU 2016 ANNUAL CRAFT SALE

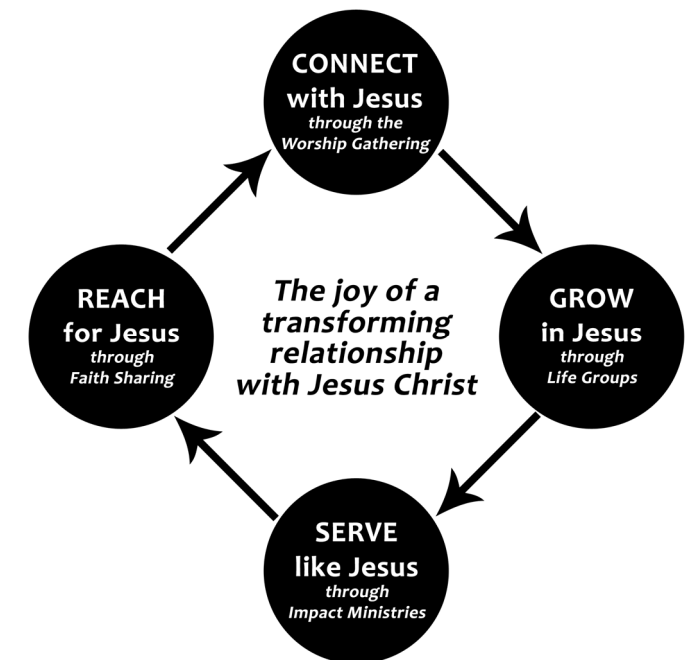
