

It's a very small butterfly shaped blanket, 10"-12", that's used in the NICU unit at Women's Hospital. The blankets are laid against the mother's chest when she holds her baby. The mother's "smell" is transferred to the blanket. When the baby is returned to the incubator, the blankie goes with the baby. The mother's "smell" comforts the baby! Isn't that wonderful?


Missions Extravaganza will be held at First Baptist
