HELP PBA MAKE MORE AND BETTER DISCIPLES!

The Piedmont Baptist Association has set a goal of \$10,000 for the Shubal Stearns Offering this year. **We need to contribute to this offering, which is aimed at Making More and Better Disciples through Promoting Church Planting, Building up the Existing Church and Assisting our Communities.**

One-third of this offering will help support a Hispanic Church Planting Catalyst tasked with helping reach the 50,000 Hispanics in the Piedmont Baptist Association with the Gospel. **As you may be aware, Rev. Steve King, FABC's own Associate Pastor, has been involved with PBA in interviewing a Spanish-speaking person to help establish Hispanic Home Churches in this area.**

One-third will go to build up the existing Church by working to revitalize plateaued or declining churches. The final one-third will go to assist our communities. You can read more about this in the bulletin insert, **but one of the things being done here is something else Friendly Avenue Baptist Church is involved in - Pocket 30 Prayer Walks.** (You may have participated in prayer walks in Lost Pocket 30, located in northeast Greensboro.) **Perhaps you were unable to participate but would like to help financially by giving to the Shubal Stearns Offering.**
